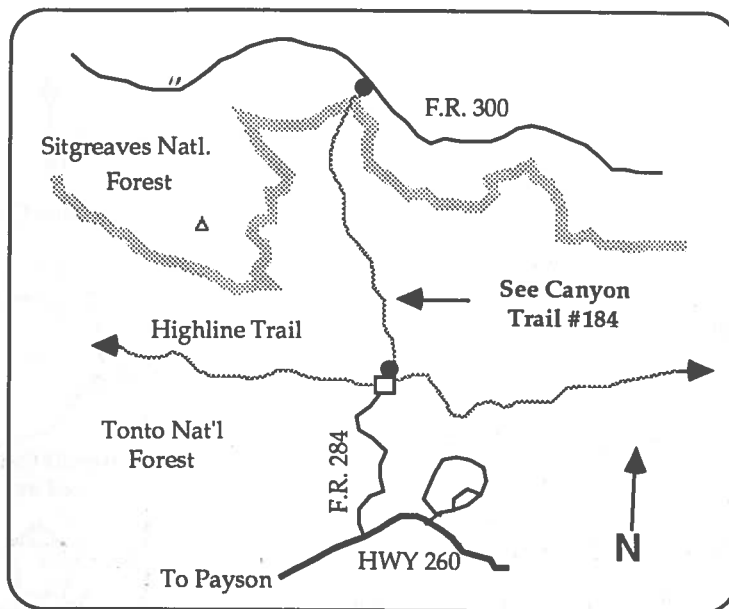


# See Canyon Trail #184

**TRAIL DESCRIPTION:** To arrive at the trailhead, go about 21 miles northeast of Payson on Hwy 260 to Forest Road 284. The trail begins at the end of F.R. 284 approximately one mile from the intersection of Hwy 260 and F.R. 284. The trail follows Christopher Creek to the top of the Mogollon Rim. The Highline Trail #31 intersects with the See Canyon Trail 1/4 mile east of F.R. 284 and runs between F.R. 284 and F.R. 300 for a total length of 3.2 miles. The trail passes near Promontory Butte.
