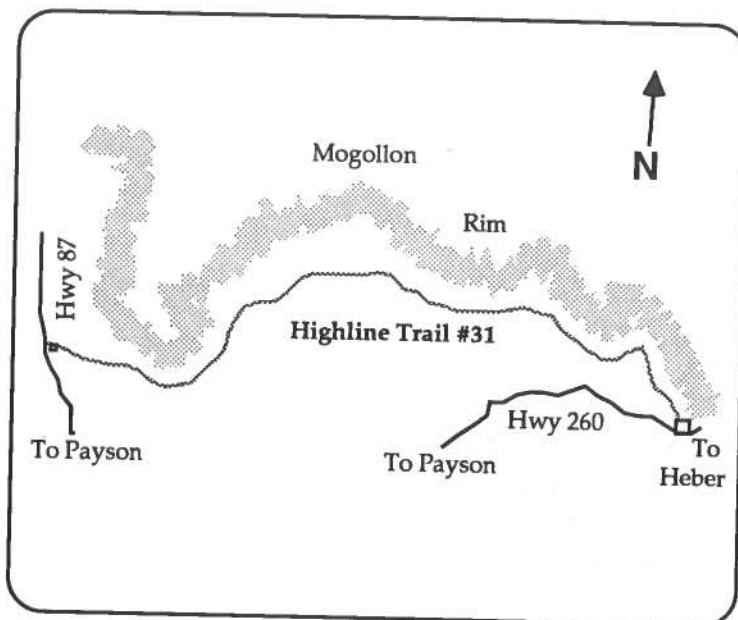


Highline Trail #31

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The Highline Trail begins just south of the Camp Geronimo Boy Scout Camp on Forest Road 440 and ends at its intersection with Hwy 260 approximately 7 miles east of Christopher Creek. The trail passes along the base of the Mogollon Rim and offers spectacular views of the Rim to the north and the Mazatzal Wilderness to the south.
